

Melbourne Institute of Technology (MIT)

MIT is located at 388 Lonsdale Street in Melbourne and caters to an international student cohort. There are currently about 1,800 - 2,000 students enrolled at MIT.

The Institute's courses include:

- General English and English for Academic Preparation courses
- Higher Education Diplomas in Business, Information Technology and Networking
- Masters degrees in Networking and Professional Accounting

MIT is also a partner institute of the University of Ballarat (UB). Under this arrangement, MIT provides teaching staff, facilities and student support services and UB is responsible for quality control of courses and conferral of degrees. Students may study a range of fully accredited UB programs:

- Bachelor degrees in Commerce (Accounting), Management, Business Information Systems and Information Technology
- Masters degrees in Business Administration (International Management), Information Technology, Information Systems and Commerce (Professional Accounting)

MIT students enrolled in UB courses may study under a fast-track three semester system, allowing students to undertake three semesters of study in one calendar year.

MIT students are eligible for **CAVAL cards**.
